Christchurch Multicultural Council (Incorporated) (CMC) is a voluntary organisation working, and providing advocacy, for ethnic communities for the last 34 years. Christchurch boasts an incredibly diverse community, with over 180 ethnicities represented in our city!

What is CMC and what do we do?

CMC promotes the awareness and acceptance of a multicultural society, cooperating with central and local government agencies and a number of NGOs working for the ethnic and wider sectors. CMC encourages the development and strengthening of ethnic groups that promote the unique social and cultural life that exists within their community towards greater social cohesion. We help to create greater pride within our culturally diverse New Zealand society.
